ANTI-RAGGING CELL

As per the order of Supreme Court of India and subsequent Notification from University Grants Commission (UGC), ragging constitutes one or more of any intention by any student or group of students on:

1. Any act of Indiscipline, Teasing or Handling with Rudeness.
2. Any act that Prevents, Disrupts the Regular Academic Activity.
3. Any activity which is likely to cause Annoyance, hardship, Psychological Harm or creates Fear or Apprehension.
4. Any Act of Financial Extortion or Forceful Expenditure.
5. Any Act of Physical Abuse causing Assault, Harm or danger to Health.
6. Any Act of abuse by spoken words, emails, SMS or public insult or through Social Media Platform etc.
7. Any Act of injury or infringement of the fundamental right to the human dignity.
8. Any Act of Wrongful Confinement, Kidnapping, molesting or committing unnatural offences, use of criminal forces, trespass or intimidation.
9. Any unlawful assembly or conspiracy to ragging.

The main functions of the committee are

- To disseminate information against indulging in any kind of ragging issued by The Honourable Supreme Court of India.
- To organize awareness Programmes on gender equity, human rights and dignity, moral and ethical values.
- To examine the complaints lodged by the students on any kind of Ragging and to conduct an enquiry in this regard.
- To formulate strategies to prevent and discourage menace of Ragging on and off the campus.

Scope of the Anti- Ragging Cell

The Anti-Ragging Cell functions in the following areas.

- Receive complaints on any matters related to Ragging.
- Conduct enquiry in accordance to the guidelines laid down by the UGC and Assam University.
- Recommends actions to be initiated against the culprits including suggestions to forward the matter to the Principal.

Procedure of the Anti-Ragging Cell

The Anti-Ragging Cell will follow the following procedure.

- Receive the complaints in writing from the concerned students.
- Examine the matter in detail on the basis of available documents.
- Recommend to the Principal to initiate disciplinary action against the culprit.

Punishment to those found guilty

Any student or group of students found guilty of ragging in the campus or even outside the campus shall be liable for punishments as per rules.

Objectives of Anti Ragging Committee

Anti-Ragging Committee will be the Supervisory and Advisory Committee in preserving a Culture of Ragging Free Environment in the college Campus. The Anti-Ragging Squad-office bearers will work under the Supervision of Anti Ragging Committee and to engage in the works of checking places like Hostels, Buses, Canteens, Classrooms and other places of student congregation. Anti-Ragging Committee will be involved in designing strategies and action plan for curbing the Menace of Ragging in the college by adopting array of activities.

Responsibilities of Anti Ragging Squad

Anti-Ragging Squad will be working under the Monitoring of Anti Ragging Committee and will seek advice from the Anti-Ragging Committee. The functions of Anti-Ragging Squad will be to keep a vigil and stop the incidences of Ragging, if any, happening / reported in the places of Student aggregation including, Classrooms, Canteens, Buses, Grounds, Hostels etc. The Squad will also educate the students at large by adopting various means about the menace of Ragging and related Punishments there to. A gamut of positive reinforcement activities are adopted by Anti-Ragging Squad for orienting students and molding their personality for a better cause. They shall work in Consonance and Guidance of Anti Ragging Committee.

Information for student:

In pursuance to the Judgment of the Hon'ble Supreme Court of India dated 8.5.2009 in Civil Appeal No. 887/2009, the UGC notified "Regulations on Curbing the Menace of Ragging in Higher Educational Institutions, 2009" and in compliance of the 2nd Amendment in UGC Regulations, it is compulsory for each student and his/her parent/Guardian to submit an online undertaking each academic year at either of the two designated web sites, namely, <https://www.antiragging.in> and <https://amanmovement.org> As part of UGC's initiative towards reduction of compliance burden of its stakeholders, UGC has revised the procedure for students to file online Anti Ragging Affidavit.

On line undertaking in every academic year to be submitted by each student and every parent, in compliance with the UGC Regulations and its 2nd Amendment regarding submission of undertaking

The revised procedure is as follows:

Step 1: A student will submit his/her details on the same web sites (www.antiragging.in and www.amanmovement.org) as before; read and confirm that he/she and his/her parents/Guardians have read and understood the regulations on curbing the menace of ragging. He/She will confirm & agree that he/she will not engage in ragging in any form. (Step 1 is the same like before).

Step 2: The student will and a web link. The student in his / her university/college receive an E MAIL with his/her registration number will forward the link to the E mail of the Nodal officer of his /her college(Please note that the student will not receive pdf affidavits and he/she is not required to print & sign it as used to be the case earlier .

Step 3: The Nodal Officer in the university/college can click on the link of any forwarded emails that he/she will receive from any student of his/her college to get the list of those students who have submitted Anti Ragging Affidavits/Undertakings in his/her college. The list will be updated every 24 hours.
